

- Digitalarkivet **Emigration Search**: ONE Search can cover the three **Oslo/Kristiania** emigration sources. How? Use **Advanced Person Search**. Once there, (Step 1) under **Category**, choose 'Emigration records' and then 'emigration register'. (Step 2) under **Geography**, choose Østlandet and then 03 Oslo and then 0301 Oslo. After making these choices add name and other options found under **Individual Information, Period (years range), Event Information or Related Person**. Then choose **Search**. [this process recommended per 2020 Fred Matson Email to and response from Ketil R. Hansen of Norway's Digitalarkivet].
- **Note**: Use the same process for other Norway Ports: Trondheim , Bergen and Stavanger. Step (1) under Category, choose 'Emigration records' then 'emigration register'. Step (2) under Geography, uses the same process but varies by port:
  - **Trondheim** port (Geography = Trøndelag | 16 Sør-Trøndelag | 1601 Trondheim);
  - **Bergen** port (Geography = Vestlandet | 13 Bergen | 1301 Bergen;
  - **Stavanger** port (Geography = Vestlandet | 11 Rogaland | 1103 Stavanger.
    - **Note**: it appears that Stavanger emigrations are not available prior to Year 1903!
  - **Also**, you can combine a search of one or more of Oslo, Trondheim, Bergen and Stavanger ports in ONE search by adding one or more ports under Geography choices.
  - **And** if you only choose 'Emigration records' and 'emigration register' under Category and make no choices under Geography, the system will generate search results for all Norway emigration records from all passenger ports.
